

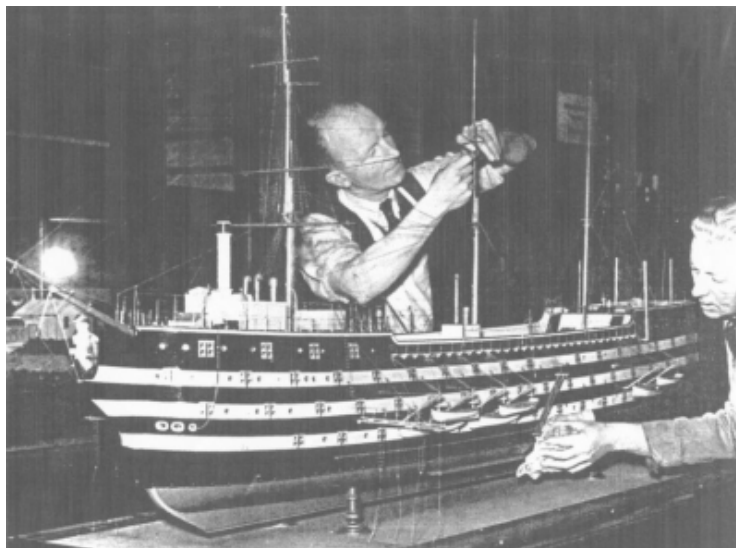
E-Mail dated 13th Aug 2009 from Graham about the sad destruction of the Exmouth Model.

Good morning all,

I regret to advise that written evidence of the destruction of this fine model was authorised by the College Principle in September 1971.

At that time the model was sited on the first floor of Ingress Abbey and visible from the tennis courts.

The model had been found with it's protective glass case removed and the model badly damaged, by person(s) unknown. The Principle found the model so badly damaged as to be beyond repair and that he had no hesitation in condemning. The model was destroyed!
